## Update on the New Royal Ottawa Hospital

### **SITE PREPARATION for the NEW ROYAL OTTAWA HOSPITAL**

*This bulletin is the third in a series as part of our communications plan to inform staff, patients, volunteers, and the community about the re-development of the new Royal Ottawa Hospital.*

*Construction crews from EllisDon have been on the Royal Ottawa Hospital campus as of November 25th, 2004. The Merivale Road entrance through to the ring road has been completed, as well as the construction of short term/metered parking.*

#### **PHASE 1**

##### **Week of December 13th, 2004**

Beginning on **Monday, December 13th, 2004**, the following site activities will be taking place:

- Setup of temporary construction trailer and storage container;
- Construction area will be fenced-off;
- Set of gates will be installed at Carling Avenue entrance for entry of construction vehicles to building site;
- Excavation and backfill will be conducted for sewage and water connection to construction trailer complex;
- Roadway will be widened at entrance for construction trailer complex;
- Site furnishings (basketball nets, gazebos, light standards) will be removed where necessary.

##### **Possible additional site activities for the week of December 13th:**

- Demolition of oil bunker and ROH temporary trailers;
- Power and lighting installed for temporary parking lot;
- Siamese connection relocated.
