BUILDING ACTIVITIES for the NEW ROYAL OTTAWA HOSPITAL

This bulletin is the sixth in a series as part of our communications plan to inform staff, patients, volunteers, and the community about the re-development of the new Royal Ottawa Hospital.

PHASE 3

The following activities have been ongoing over the past two weeks:

- Installation of site services
- Mass excavation
- Rock removal
- Installation of temporary power for Crane # 1 and 2
- Preparation of staging area

In addition to the activities listed above, the following activities will commence the week of January 24th:

- EllisDon will move into their new site offices
- Base for Crane#1 will be formed/poured on Monday, January 24th
- Crane #1 will be erected Thursday January 27th and Friday January 28th
- Storage portion of the tunnel will be removed
- Excavation, installation of west wing sanitary line, including backfill, will take place

IMPORTANT

CARLING AVENUE IS AN ENTRANCE ONLY. Please do NOT exit using this roadway. Anyone using the **CARD ACCESS EXIT to Merivale Road MUST TURN RIGHT ONLY** to avoid collisions with those exiting using the main Merivale Road entrance/exit. To turn left from the hospital campus, use the main Merivale Road entrance/exit roadway.
