## SUMMER PHASE OF THE NEW ROYAL OTTAWA HOSPITAL CONSTRUCTION

*This bulletin is the ninth in a series as part of our communications plan to inform staff, patients, volunteers, and the community about the re-development of the new Royal Ottawa Hospital.*

The construction of the new hospital is still on schedule, and progressing at a fast pace. There will soon be changes in the personnel and types of work being done on the site. Beginning this month, there will be an influx of new workers made up of the finishing trades, including electricians, plumbers, and painters, who will begin the work on the inside of the new building.. Arrangements have been made to accommodate any additional parking requirements, but if there are any issues that arise, please do not hesitate to call us.

Beginning June 27th, there will be a considerable amount of activity along the Merivale access road. Starting at the Merivale Road end, there will be storm/sanitation service construction occurring, which will necessitate the tearing up of various parts of the access road and parking lot. This activity will take place over a period of several weeks, in order to minimize the disruption to parking arrangements, and facilitate hospital access at all times. During each phase, there will be flagmen on duty to ensure traffic flow is maintained, and appropriate pedestrian walkways indicated.

Please continue to obey all the traffic signs, pay attention to posted speed limits, and watch for pedestrians out to enjoy the summer weather.
